

Macmillan Fundraising Terms & Conditions - Mighty Hike Series

- For this Challenge you are required to pay the Organiser of the Events, Threshold Sports Limited a registration fee of £25, which is non-refundable. As the Agent of the Event Organiser, Macmillan Cancer Support Trading Limited will collect this Fee from you at the point of registration, and pass it on to the Event Organiser.
- In addition to the payment of the registration fee, you must pledge to raise a minimum of £250 in sponsorship money for Macmillan Cancer Support which should be received by Macmillan Cancer Support within one month of the Challenge. All funds raised through the Challenge must be payable to Macmillan Cancer Support in £ sterling. The objective is to raise as much sponsorship as possible.
- Should you, for whatever reason, not take your place, all sponsorship forms and monies collected should be forwarded to Macmillan Cancer Support or returned to your sponsors.
- You confirm that you are medically fit and that you participate in the event at your own risk. Macmillan Cancer Support will not be held responsible for injury or illness resulting from your participation.
- You understand that it is your responsibility to read any terms and conditions issued by Threshold Sports Limited and to comply with these.
- You confirm that you will be the minimum age on event day, as dictated by Threshold Sports Limited.
- You have provided Macmillan Cancer Support certain information, including medical information, about you and consent to Macmillan using this data for the purposes that you have given the data for. You understand that it will be necessary for Macmillan Cancer Support to share the data with Threshold Sports Limited and their medical staff in order to organise this event.
- We do not sell or swap your details with any third parties, but in order to carry out our work we may need to pass your details to service companies authorised to act on our behalf.
- All participants, supporters and spectators, including friends and families who choose to attend the event confirm that they are happy for their names, video footage and photographs taken of them during the event to be used to publicise the event by Macmillan Cancer Support and its trading companies (Macmillan Cancer Support Trading Ltd and Macmillan Cancer Support Sales Ltd) for commercial and fundraising purposes including, but not limited to marketing materials, television broadcasts, social media, advertising, publications and other documents or mediums that may be made available to the public. Photographs of children will not be used in this manner without express written consent unless the images are incidental; for example, children's images at the starting line.
